

Hello Seniors and Senior Families! We are down to our final few days with our soon to be graduates! Congratulations!

Graduation: Graduation will be **Saturday, June 12th at 2:00pm**. We will be having our ceremony at **Doc Harris Stadium**. Graduates should arrive at stadium at **1:00pm**. Students will receive 12 tickets for their family & friends. Tickets have been given to students on campus. If your senior has been remote learning, please stop by front office to pick up your tickets. Nobody will be admitted without a ticket, as we are being held to COVID protocol rules. Masks must worn on CSD grounds.

Seating: There will be designated locations where your party of **12 can sit together. These areas will be designated with tape on the seats. Please do NOT sit anyplace that does not have tape and remember that your group must sit together.** Seat selection will be on a first come basis. However, keep in mind there is plenty of room and not a bad seat in the stadium for our size of ceremony. **Gates will open at 1:15pm.** *****If you have any family that has issues with stairs and will need ground seating, please let us know, by calling 360-833-5600, so we can make sure to have this set up.**

Graduation Rehearsal: We will have **mandatory** rehearsals on Thursday, June 10 and Friday, June 11 during the school day. Practice time will be 1:00pm - 3:00pm on both days.

Graduation Ceremony Pictures: We will have a photographer onsite, that will be taking pictures of the graduates on stage holding their diploma, as well as some candid shots during the staging time prior to graduation. We will then send you a link that will allow you to download pictures.

Graduation Etiquette For Spectators: Gates will open at 1:15pm. You must have a ticket to be admitted. Seating is first come first serve with plenty of room in the designated taped areas. **Please make sure that your group of 12, stays together (Unless an alternate plan has been made with us prior).** Please remember this is a celebration for ALL our graduates, so please cheer as loud as you want during your students time on stage and allow for others to do the same for their student. No blow horns, confetti, beach balls or silly string (basically anything that leaves a mess or is a distraction). You will also not be allowed on the field after the ceremony. You will have to meet up with your graduate in the parking lot after the ceremony.

Cap Decorations: Cap decorations are allowed, but need to be school appropriate and need to be reviewed and approved by Mrs. Holmes, prior to graduation. They must just be the top of the cap and flat. Nothing can be hanging off or on the sides of the cap.

Senior BBQ & Yearbooks: We will be having a BBQ for our seniors on Friday here at school on the back patio between 12:00-1:00 (prior to practice). They will receive their yearbooks on Thursday after practice and can use their normal lunch time and this BBQ time to sign them. If you did not order a yearbook and would like one, contact the front office ASAP to make arrangements to get one of the extras we have ordered.

Senior Mailbox: It is a long standing tradition for friends and families to send in letters to seniors that are gathered by our "Graduation Post Office". They are given to the seniors on graduation day. The deadline for turning these in was June 4th, however, you can still bring them to our office and we will be sure to get them in their mail envelope. Incomplete Grades: Any incompletes from previous quarters should be made up this week. Please make sure there is a game plan in place with teachers on how to get these taken care of. If you have been given any independent work, such as a PE contract, this should be getting turned in as well.

Chromebooks & Fines: Chromebooks will be turned in on June 9th, 10th & 11th. If they are not turned in a fine will be assessed. We mailed out a current fine/fee statements a few weeks ago and mailed out updated ones today, so please be sure to take care of those items as soon as possible. **Transcript and diplomas will be held until all fines/fees are paid and chromebooks returned.**
