A completed Student Health Inventory Form is required for each student **annually** which includes immunization information. Students are required to have a medical form signed by a doctor if they are to take medication at school. All student medications at school must be stored in the health room in coordination with our health room staff.

Athletes must have a current physical, which is good for two years from the date of the exam, a concussion form, a medical emergency form, and must have purchased an ASB card (\$25) and paid the per sport athletic fee (\$30) before the first practice.
