Attendance

Victoria Wood, our Attendance Tech, will be a main contact at school. These are some of the many reasons for communicating with Attendance:

- Notify school of student's absence with reason via telephone, email, or Parent Square within three days of the absence. Absences may include illness, injury, or out of town. Please leave a message if you get voice mail as it is checked when time allows.
- Pre-arrange a student's need to leave school during school hours for appointments or other events. Notes or emails at the beginning of the school day are best.
- Students entering or leaving school need to be signed in or out in the main office using our QR code posted by the front doorbell.
- Request permission to ride a bus with a friend. Requests should be made by 10 AM to be cleared through transportation.
- Requests for afterschool changes to regular plans should be made by 1 PM to ensure the student is notified.

There are many people willing and able to help you with caring for your student. Below you will find the proper person to reach or tool to use for the various reasons:

Skyward: Progress for assignments, tests, and attendance are available on Skyward. Parent logins and passwords will be emailed at the beginning of the school year. This is the best way to track your student's progress as there is no formal parent/teacher conference.

Mrs. Bush assists the Athletic Director to manage student registration for all sports. Online registration is completed through FamilyID. Only the physical form needs to be physically returned to Mrs. Bush.

Staff is available to assist students with health needs and monitor health records.



Student Programs

Athletic programs that may be offered to students include 8th grade football, 6/7/8 cross country, 6/7/8 wrestling, 7/8 girls volleyball, 7/8 basketball, unified sports, intramurals, and 6/7/8 track.

Academic programs that may be offered include Robotics, Science Olympiad, Knowledge Bowl, Math Olympiad, GeoBee competition, Skyridge Network News, school musical, jazz band, jazz choir, Skyhawks FIRST, yearbook, and Associated Student Body (ASB).

Miscellaneous

Back to School Open House for Incoming New Students in the fall: Prior to school beginning, you will be invited to this event to pick up schedules and to find lockers and classrooms.

Cell Phone Use: The **student handbook** outlines the school policy on cell phone use.

Core Classes: Core classes are English Language Arts, Social Studies, Science, and Math. Your student will participate in these classes daily.

Curriculum Night: This event highlights the year's curriculum plan including projects and activities.

Dress Code: Please refer to the **student handbook** for this policy.

Drop Off/Pick Up Procedures: Parents using the loop should pull as far forward as possible to allow for the maximum number of cars to drop off students at one time. Dining room doors and main office doors are accessible during this time. The upper and lower lots should NOT be used for drop off/pick up.

Early Pick Up/Medical Appointments: Parents should call, email, or send a note to the Attendance Tech at the beginning of the day with the reason and dismissal time. Students will receive a release slip to be in the office for pick up at the appropriate time.

Health Inventory and Immunization: All students must have the recommended vaccinations and provide Certificate of Immunization Status to the school according to state law. The annual Student Health Inventory should also be submitted to the school, both forms by the first day of school.

All students are required to have a newly completed Health Inventory form on file each year. Forms are emailed to parents in August and available online and at the back to school open house.

Lockers and Backpacks: Students are assigned a locker and are expected to store their backpacks in the locker. Backpacks are not allowed in the classrooms as it may pose a tripping hazard.

School Supplies: A list of school supplies your student will need for the year will be posted on the website. These supplies should be brought to school during the first week of school, not during the Back to School Open house event.

Star Classes: Star classes rotate between Fitness/Health and your student's elective class. This is where the SKY and HAWK rotation comes into play. Students are taught which day (SKY or HAWK) is associated with which class. A SKY/HAWK calendar can be found on the website for easy reference.
